Regulation No. 144/20 of the Rector of Poznan University of Medical Sciences of 25 November 2020

on the change of Regulation No. 124/20 on the organization of education and academic year 2020/2021

According to Section 28 (1) of Poznan University of Medical Sciences Statutes, it is provided as follows:

Section 1

The change of Regulation No. 124/20 of 16 October 2020 on the organization of education and academic year 2020/2021 (changed with Regulations No. 130/2020 of 30 October 2020 and No. 139/20 of 10 November 2020), so that Section 1 is amended as follows:

'Section 1

Within the scope, which is not regulated hereunder, with the reservation of the regulations of the Rector of Poznan University of Medical Sciences: No. 52 of 28 May 2020 (amended by the Regulation No. 82 of 17 July 2020 and No. 88 of 6 August 2020), No. 82 of 17 July 2020 (amended by the Regulation No. 90 of 8 August 2020):

- 1. From 28 November to 21 December 2020, all classes, except for the classes developing practical skills, carried out at Poznan University of Medical Sciences are conducted using only methods and techniques of distance learning.
- The Dean of the Faculty in cooperation with the course coordinators creates the list of
 courses developing practical skills which are conducted in the form of in-person
 classes. If delivering practical classes developing practical skills requiring solely direct
 contact is impossible, such classes shall be scheduled later, and the Dean decides in
 this respect of the Faculty.
- 3. Until further notice, in-person exams at the Center for Innovative Education Techniques (*Centrum Innowacyjnych Technik Kształcenia CITK*) are postponed.
- 4. Post-graduate education and education in the Doctoral School are conducted using only methods and techniques of distance learning except for the classes developing practical skills in the medical profession, which cannot be held on-line.
- 5. According to the Regulation of Ministry of Education of 23 October 2020 on the teaching standards of studies preparing to practice as a medical doctor, doctor of dentistry, pharmacist, nurse, midwife, laboratory diagnostician, physiotherapist and paramedic (Journal of Laws 2019.1573 as amended) students of studies preparing to practice as a medical doctor, doctor of dentistry, pharmacist, nurse, midwife, laboratory diagnostician, physiotherapist and paramedic employed at the temporary hospital at Poznan International Fairs or students who have performed duties along with tasks performed by other medical entities or sanitary-epidemiological services due to

infection of virus SARS-CoV-2, may apply to get credit for parts of courses or groups of courses according to the regulations decided by the Dean of the Faculty.

Section 2

- 1. Execution of the Regulation is entrusted to the Vice-Rector for Teaching in cooperation with the Deans of the Faculties.
- 2. The Deans of the Faculties are obliged to adapt existing decisions concerning the organisation of teaching activities to this Regulation.

Section 3

This Regulation takes effect on 28 November 2020.
