The Library's collection

The Main Library collects and provides users with scientific and educational literature in the fields of medical sciences, health sciences, and related disciplines.

We offer students of the Poznan University of Medical Sciences the opportunity to use the Library's printed collections both by borrowing them and by using them on site at the Library.

Any student of the Poznań University of Medical Sciences may also become a user of licensed electronic resources.

Access to the collection

- Remote access to e-resources.
 - Using Library materials on site: materials are available to use only in the Library.
 - Using Library materials outside: the Library book collection from the Circulation Desk and the Store Room is available for users to borrow. Students are entitled to borrow books from the Library after signing up at the Circulation Desk.

Remote access to e-resources

Access within the University Computer Network

Any student of Poznan University of Medical Sciences may become a user of licensed electronic resources. On-site access to e-resources is available from all computers and devices connected to the University's computer network, including:

- desktop computers in the Main Library,
- desktop computers registered within the University network in PUMS units,
- personal mobile devices connected via the Eduroam PUMS network.

Remote Access

The remote access service enables the use of electronic resources from any location. This service is available exclusively to individuals with an active Library account, including employees, students, and doctoral candidates of PUMS; participants in PUMS postgraduate programmes; and individuals cooperating with the University who possess a personal e-mail address in the @ump.edu.pl domain.





On-site access


Main Reading Room

Basic information

- is available to anyone interested in medical literature,
- offers free access to a reference collection of books – literature in the field of medical sciences and health sciences, as well as professional service from librarians on duty,
- provides a place for quiet study and work in a spacious room.

Use

- orders for collections from controlled depositories can be placed with the librarian on duty.
- with the librarian's consent it is possible to use the journals on the premises of the Main Library outside the Reading Room,
- in the Reading Room, you can use a workstation adapted for visually impaired people.
- users can scan, print, and copy on self-service Documaster Campus devices.
- the Eduroam wireless network is available in the Reading Room.
- When using the Reading Room, we kindly ask you not to bring any outerwear, bags, backpacks, etc.



On-site access

Periodicals Reading Room

Basic information

- is available to anyone interested in medical literature,
- offers free access to the latest editions of collected Polish and foreign journals and professional service from librarians on duty,
- provides a place for quiet study and work in a spacious room.

Use

- orders for journals from controlled depositories can be placed with the librarian on duty,
- with the librarian's consent it is possible to use the journals on the premises of the Main Library outside the Reading Room,
- users can scan, print and copy on self-service Documaster Campus devices,
- eduroam wireless network is available in the Reading Room,
- when using the Reading Room, we kindly ask you not to bring any outerwear, bags, backpacks, etc.




Circulation

We encourage students of Poznan University of Medical Sciences to make use of the Circulation Desk.

To borrow books, students must have an active Reader Account. Those with an active account can borrow up to 20 items at a time for a period of 180 days.

Books can be borrowed directly from the open-shelf collection or requested via the online catalogue.

Reader Account

An active Reader Account in the PUMS Library allows you to borrow books and access e-resources from any computer. Registration is possible via online form.

The user receives a temporary "barcode number" that allows them to log in to the Reader's Account and order books from the catalogue.

The account is temporary. To gain full functionality of the account, you must within 14 days confirm your personal data at the Circulation Desk (the basis for verification is to present a valid student ID).

Individual Study Booths

Booths are available to all students of Poznan University of Medical Sciences. They are intended to provide a quiet space for individual study, research, and academic work. Each booth is equipped with a computer workstation offering access to the Internet and licensed electronic resources.

Booking

To reserve a Booth, please contact the Information Desk (1st floor of the Main Library) either in person or via the online form.

A Booth may be booked for a maximum of six hours per day. The reservation may be extended, subject to availability.

Booths can be reserved up to one week in advance.

Using

Before using a Booth, users are required to present a valid student ID at the Information Desk.

A delay of more than 15 minutes may result in the cancellation of the reservation and the allocation of the Booth to another user.

Leaving the Booth for more than one hour will be considered a resignation from the reservation.



Group Study Rooms

Rooms are available to groups of students of Poznan University of Medical Sciences consisting of at least three members. All rooms are equipped with dry-erase boards (mobile flipcharts). Selected rooms additionally provide multimedia projectors.

Booking

To reserve a Room, please contact the Information Desk (1st floor of the Main Library) either in person or via the online form.

A Room may be booked for a maximum of six hours per day. The reservation may be extended, subject to availability.

Rooms can be reserved up to one week in advance.

Using

Before using a Room, users are required to present a valid student ID at the Information Desk.

A delay of more than 15 minutes may result in the cancellation of the reservation and the allocation of the Room to another user.


Leaving the Room for more than one hour will be regarded as a resignation from its use.

The last person leaving the Room is kindly requested to inform the Information Desk accordingly.



Open space

It is located on 1st, 2nd and 3rd floor of the Main Library. The space is available to all Library users. It provides an environment for independent study and self-education, completing individual and group tasks, as well as spending breaks between classes. In the open space, users can take advantage of both comfortable sofas and workstations at tables. A drinking water dispenser is available on each floor.



Chill-out Zone



The Zone is located on the third floor of the Library (room 4.13). It is available to all users. In the Zone, users can make use of the board games, puzzles, and books available as part of the room's equipment. Users are allowed to consume their own food and drinks. Comfortable sofas and loungers are available, providing an ideal space for relaxation.
