TUITION FEES

Tuition

Medicine:

- years 1-2: 71 000 PLN / year
- years 3-6: 85 750 PLN / year

Dentistry:

- years 1-2: 75 250 PLN / year
- years 3-5: 80 000 PLN / year

Payment schedule

- 1st installment: date specified in acceptance e-mail
- 2nd installment: September 30, 2026
- 3rd installment: February 15, 2027
- 4th installment: April 15, 2027

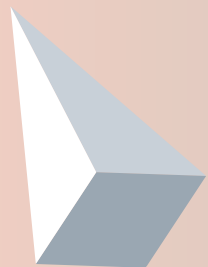

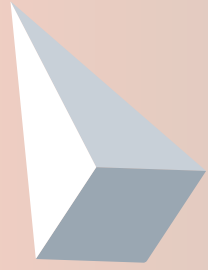
Secondary school certificates from abroad are not recognized automatically in Poland unless they come from specific countries. Your diploma must undergo a formal individual recognition procedure, conducted by NAWA – the Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange.

It is important that you obtain an Individual Recognition Statement confirming that your high school certificate entitles you to commence higher education in Poland. This is required for final admission.

- > Ongoing health insurance required for the entire study period (not travel insurance); Polish national insurance (NFZ) recommended. (comprehensive insurance policy can be acquired at low cost upon arrival to Poznan - more info at Orientation)
- > University will not cover the costs of your medical treatment
- > Polish citizens can get insured by the University - inquire with your class coordinator at the Dean's Office

IMMIGRATIONS

LEGALIZATION OF STAY IN POLAND

- > Visa or other document confirming legality of stay in Poland required upon entry and throughout the whole duration of your stay
- > Polish citizens can simply use their Polish passport or Polish ID
- > All international students from outside EU intending to study in Poland should obtain student visas from a Polish consulate before arriving
- > Visas can be extended in Poznan, but it is required to apply before the expiration date
- > EU and EFTA citizens may enter Poland without permits, but must register their stay in Poland
